The **Residence Pass-Talent (RP-T)** is a 10-year renewable pass administered by Talent Corporation Malaysia Berhad (TalentCorp) in collaboration with the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Immigration Department of Malaysia.

The special long-term pass is designed for expatriates who are currently working in Malaysia and intend to continue contributing to the country's economic growth over the long term.

**RP-T is designed for highly skilled professionals who are:**



Currently employed in Malaysia under an Employment Pass



Have an established employment and tax record in Malaysia



Intend to remain in Malaysia for long-term career continuity



Require flexibility to manage career progression



## WHY CHOOSE RP-T?

### RP-T provides long-term stability, flexibility and peace of mind.

- ✓ **Live and work in Malaysia for up to 10 years**  
Enjoy the stability of a long-term, renewable pass.
- ✓ **Freedom to change employers**  
Move between employers without the need to apply for a new pass.
- ✓ **Bring your family with you**  
Your spouse\* and children under 18 are eligible for the RP-T Dependant Pass.
- ✓ **Work opportunities for your spouse\***  
Your spouse\* may seek employment in Malaysia without requiring a separate Employment Pass.
- ✓ **Education access for your children**  
Your spouse\* and children under 18 may study in Malaysia (primary and secondary education).
- ✓ **Support for your extended family**  
Parents, parents-in-law and dependants over 18 may apply for a Long-Term Social Visit Pass (LTSVP), renewable up to 5 years.

*\*Spouse refers to a legally married spouse according to the Malaysian Government's law.*

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS







### To be considered for the RP-T, applicants must first meet the following minimum eligibility requirements:

- Currently working in Malaysia under an Employment Pass for at least **3 consecutive years**.
- Hold a valid Employment Pass with a minimum of **3 months' validity**.
- Earn a basic monthly salary of **RM15,000 or above** (excluding allowances and bonuses).
- Has a Malaysian income tax file number and has paid taxes for at least the most recent 2 years. The declared yearly basic salary must be a minimum of **RM180,000**, in line with the required monthly income threshold.
- Possess a **minimum of 5 years of total work experience**.
- Hold recognised academic qualifications or professional certifications.

*The above sets out the minimum eligibility requirements for the RP-T. Meeting these requirements does not guarantee approval, which remains subject to the RP-T Panel's discretion.*

## HOW TO APPLY?

### Applications are submitted online through the RP-T portal.

-  **Check your eligibility** and register an account in the RP-T system. → [rpt.talentcorp.com.my](https://rpt.talentcorp.com.my)
-  **Prepare and upload** the required supporting documents.
-  **Submit your application** and pay the prescribed application fee.
-  **Application review and notification** via email.
-  **Submit endorsement documents** (if approved).
-  **Pay the immigration fee** and **download your RP-T electronic pass (ePASS)**.
